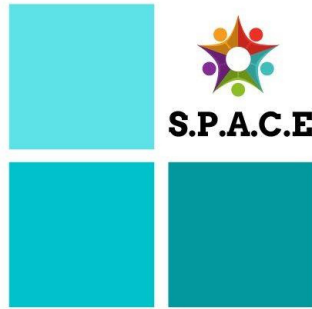




STAFF PROFESSIONALS ACROSS THE CONTINUUM OF EDUCATION
